#### Now forming the Hurricane Relief Team for Spring of 2020!



#### Haiti: June 22- July 4 \*Medical Professionals Wanted\*

This team will partner with Greg Barshaw and Connect 2 Ministries in Port-au-Prince. They will have the opportunity to come alongside

Christians in some of the poorest areas of Haiti. The ministry of this team will be decided by the makeup of the participants and their skills. A variety of options range from running a week long medical clinic to running a week long VBS program for a local church. The team will get to know and worship with the local church they are ministering in as they seek to encourage and equip Haitian Christians to live out the gospel in their neighborhoods. Minimum age: 18

#### Honduras: June 22- July 10

The IMPACT team will be working alongside of Orlando and Silvia Japas and the Unión Bíblica Staff and



volunteers to share Biblical values with the young people of Honduras. The people of Honduras are living through a time where children are growing up learning from cycles of family disintegration and violence. The team will have opportunities to minister within schools teaching a different way of life based on the gospel, minister alongside the local church, and form bonds with inspirational Honduran Christians. Knowledge of Spanish is helpful but not required. Minimum age: 16



#### Xpujil, Mexico: June 22-July 3 Partnering with the Outreach Foundation, this team will experience

more than just a clean water/poverty alleviation project, a relation-based work movement is happening within communities of subsistence level farmers. Many are indigenous Ch'ols, and they suffer from poor health due in part to the lack of access to clean water. Ch'ol Presbyterian laymen organize families to work together to build family-owned cisterns that collect rainfall. Year after year, hundreds of families have easy access to millions of gallons of rainwater. But most importantly, the Gospel is shared and its implications are lived out by our partners in unique ways that people clearly notice. Mutual respect grows, and we pray the Holy Spirit will empower the hearts of all involved to be assured of the grace of Jesus Christ. Minimum age: 15



#### Romania: June 22- July 10

This team will work with Dana & Brandi Bates and VIATA Program, a youth ministry sent through Young Life and

located in the mountains above the impoverished coal-mining town of Lupeni in Jiu Valley. VIATA serves to help build a sense of community and hope for better life in this economically depressed area, where people seek work, basic needs, and a vision for the future. We will work to support a summer camp for high school and middle school aged children, where they are taught outdoor skills, rock and rope climbing, and Christian values. There will also be opportunities to serve in a book camp with children and other service projects around the camp or mountain bike trail. Minimum age: 15

#### South Africa: June 22- July 10

This team will partner with African Leadership, who is committed to educating and serving the people of Africa through the teachings of the Bible and the love of

Christ. They believe in the importance of training local community members to empower and enrich their communities with the Gospel. The team will have opportunities to participate in children's ministry, preschool ministry, school ministries, construction, and local/rural evangelism. Minimum age: 16

#### Ukraine: June 22-25 (Cross Training) July 2- 17 (trip)

In Ukraine we work with Nita Hanson and God's Hidden Treasures ministry to encourage them and build relationships with the least and the lost in that community. This organization has been growing in scope and now encompasses wheelchair, orphan, medical, spiritual and outreach ministries. The team will have the opportunity to serve in many of these areas alongside Nita and GHT staff. "Our mission is to serve the needs of the poor, afflicted and the orphaned; and to bring Gods love through personal relationships in the name of Jesus Christ." Minimum age: 17

### STEPHEN MINISTRY/PRAYER NIGHT

#### **Situations Where Stephen Ministers Provide Care**

Individuals ask to meet with a Stephen Minister for a variety of reasons. According to the Stephen Ministries website, the reasons people meet with Stephen Ministers fall into 10 major categories (see chart below).

The highest ranked reason, Grief, encompasses not only grief over the death of a loved one, but also loss of a job, loss of a relationship, loss of health, loss of home or livelihood due to natural disasters like fire, earthquakes or flooding.

Health Issues cover short and long-term illnesses, hospital says due to surgery, on-going treatments, or accidents.

Personal Crises include any and all issues—small or big, short-term or long-term, that create difficulties, struggles, or hurt to an individual.



Stephen Ministers are trained to provide high-quality, confidential, Christ-centered care to people who are struggling through a difficult time in life. Stephen Ministry is non-judgmental, confidential, and can be short-term or long-term.
