

Bible Point: God doesn't change, so we trust him when we're unsure.





We had a wonderfully rich time in our **Discovering Church Membership class last Sunday** – 6 people sharing their stories, becoming better acquainted with who we are and why we do what we do, and in the end choosing to commit to “*working out their salvation*” (Phil. 2:12) within the context of the particular expression of the body of Christ we call Templeton Presbyterian Church. I’m looking forward to introducing them during worship on November 10. If you missed this edition of the “Discovering” experience, I will be facilitating another class in January.



This Sunday (November 3rd) **will be a very special Sunday**. 
ADULT MINISTRY/ DEC. DATES


