

Just typing the date in my Templetones file folder gave me a start: January 2020. **2020!** It hardly seems like 20 years ago that we were all contemplating the potential impact of turning the corner into the 21st century – would computer systems fail ... would the energy grid go down ... would access to basic services come to a standstill ... etc. etc. etc. ????? The world didn't come to a crashing halt, and here we are prepared to enter another decade.

For my household, we enter this new decade awash in puppies. Remind me never to do this again during Advent and Christmas! Two litters ... 15 furballs ... and all the feeding, cleaning, cuddling, playing, and endlessly picking up all the post-digested food they eat every day. It's a beautiful thing to witness how a mother animal – with absolutely no preparation whatsoever – knows exactly what to do when the first pup is born. They never read a book or saw a video ...



they never witnessed another dog doing it ... their mom never gave them "the talk" about puppybirth ... and yet God's gift of instinct kicks in and they get the job done.

It is because of the LOVE of God – that is, our confidence that God loves us with an everlasting, grace-given love ... a love that means he would never lie to us -> that we can trust his promises and have HOPE for the future – hope for our live and hope for the world.

It is because of the LOVE of God – a love that will not leave us as we are, but is committed to our transformation into image of Christ -> that we can have PEACE in our hearts and minds, knowing that he is always at work bringing good, even in the worst of times.

It is because of the LOVE of God – a love that has a plan and purpose for restoring this fallen world into the beauty and goodness of creation -> that we can have JOY in all things, knowing that we reside in the loving arms of our Heavenly Father and that on the other side of the suffering and sadness of this world, is a new heaven and new earth that awaits us.

And of course, each of the other three (Hope, Peace, & Joy) feed and sustain each other.

Our sure Hope in Christ grounds us in the Peace that he gives, not as the world gives.

Our Peace with God, because of our being reconciled to the Father, is our source of Joy in sharing in his glory, both now and forever.

Our Joy in sharing in God's glory, as it did for Jesus, enables us to endure suffering, with the Peace of knowing that what we've been promised cannot be taken away from us.

May we all enter this New Year's Day, this New Year, and this New Decade secure in the love of God for us, and wrapped in the hope, peace, and joy of Christ. May they be the qualities of faith that sink deep roots in our lives and give us an enduring vision to love God, love ourselves, love one another, and love the world as Jesus did ... and does.

Welcome to 2020!!




ADULT MINISTRY


Upcoming:
