Congregation prays out loud those parts in bold

Lord, we come before you with the cross behind us.

It is only because forgiveness is assured through your death and resurrection that we can come free to confess even the deepest and darkest parts of our lives.

Because "GRACE" is emblazoned on your welcome mat, we have the confidence to speak the truth about ourselves, and break free from the guilt that would otherwise enslave and condemn us. To you only we give the praise and glory.

Still, we confess that there are times when our actions betray us, and reveal those moments when we *don't* believe that grace is enough.

Forgive us when we try to add our good works to your grace by withholding our confession until we feel worthy of forgiveness, or when we hold on to our guilt long after you have forgiven us.

Forgive our tendency to take grace for granted, so that we lose both our joy and awe in the presence of your mercy.

We can be guilty both of believing too casually or too skeptically in the scandalous gift of undeserved grace.

Keep us, O Lord, from the erosive effects of both extremes, so that we might walk faithfully in the fullness of your love.
