Luke 11:1-4 (ESV)

Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples."² And he said to them, "When you pray, say:

'Father, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

³ Give us each day our daily bread,

⁴ and forgive us our sins,

for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us.

And lead us not into temptation."

Prayer of Confession (adapted from 4/9/2006)

*Congregation prays out loud those parts in **bold**.*

Lord Jesus, as the people welcomed you into Jerusalem,
we welcome you into our lives.

But we confess that too often we want you on our terms,
and not yours.

We repent reluctantly...

we shrink back from the honesty you demand...

we cringe at the commitment you require.

Like your disciples our convictions quickly crumble,
and our intentions frequently go unfulfilled.

We can cheer you on Sunday...and betray you by Thursday.

We can hail you as King on Sunday...and crucify you by Friday.

We can greet you as God's Messiah on Sunday...

and leave you buried in a tomb on Saturday.

For all that we are...and for all that we want to be...and for all that we try to be,
we remain sinners in need of your grace.

Forgive us. Cleanse us. Renew us. Strengthen us. Restore us.

For all the Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays of weakness and betrayal,

help us to live in the faithfulness of Sundays –

living under your rule as King,

and in the freedom of your grace,

as our Crucified and Risen Lord.

Time of personal, silent reflection and confession.

In your name, O Lord, we pray. **Amen.**

Matthew 19:21-35

²¹ Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" ²² Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy-seven times.

²³ "Therefore the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants. ²⁴ When he began to settle, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents. ²⁵ And since he could not pay, his master ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made. ²⁶ So the servant fell on his knees, imploring him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.' ²⁷ And out of pity for him, the master of that servant released him and forgave him the debt. ²⁸ But when that same servant went out, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii, and seizing him, he began to choke him, saying, 'Pay what you owe.' ²⁹ So his fellow servant fell down and pleaded with him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you.' ³⁰ He refused and went and put him in prison until he should pay the debt. ³¹ When his fellow servants saw what had taken place, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their master all that had taken place. ³² Then his master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me. ³³ And should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' ³⁴ And in anger his master delivered him to the jailers, until he should pay all his debt. ³⁵ So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart."
