

Romans 1:8-15

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed in all the world. ⁹ For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I mention you ¹⁰ always in my prayers, asking that somehow by God's will I may now at last succeed in coming to you. ¹¹ For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you— ¹² that is, that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine. ¹³ I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that I have often intended to come to you (but thus far have been prevented), in order that I may reap some harvest among you as well as among the rest of the Gentiles. ¹⁴ I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish. ¹⁵ So I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome.

Statement of Faith: PREAMBLE

My life belongs to a merciful God,
who is revealed to us in Christ and through the Holy Spirit,
in order that we may know and be fit for fellowship with a holy God.
I praise God for pursuing me first,
an initiative in keeping with the divine pattern begun at creation.

Statement of Faith: GOD

For I believe that GOD –

who from everlasting to everlasting co-exists with the Word and Spirit,
and though content in the shared love of the Trinity,
so desired to show the mercy of his love
that he created humankind for fellowship with himself,
to the end that the universe might be filled with God's glory.

**I weep for a humanity who in distrust, rejected the life-giving Word of God,
and to this day continues in rebellion,
seeking fulfillment through independence and self-glory,
only to live in alienation from God and in enmity with each other.**

I love this God,

who so loved his creatures and desired to be reunited in fellowship with them,
that he committed himself to the task of redemption.

To Abraham, God promised a land, a people, and the future blessing of all nations.

To David, God promised a throne and a kingdom that would endure forever.

To the nation of Israel, God promised a redeemer.

Statement of Faith: JESUS CHRIST

I believe in JESUS CHRIST –

who as the fulfillment of promise, became God's Word made flesh
so as to redeem humanity and restore creation back unto God.

**In his humanity,
the Son of God took on our nature, though without sin,
and lived in perfect trust and obedience to the Father.**

In his divinity,

he proclaimed the kingdom of God and established it
through his death and resurrection from the dead.

**His work on the cross brought redemption to a fallen world
in the good news of forgiveness for sin and reconciliation to God.**

Statement of Faith: HOLY SPIRIT

I believe in the HOLY SPIRIT –

sent by Christ to give birth to the Church and to continue the ministry of Jesus.

In continuity with Israel, the Church is the covenant people of God.

In obedience to the Lordship of Christ and in response to God's grace,
the Church is called to model the incarnate love of God and embrace all brokenness.

Thus, in love we seek out the lost

that they might find God and be reconciled to him as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Thus, in love and justice we seek out the rich and poor,
the powerful and the oppressed, the hurt and helpless,

**that they might find each other and be reconciled in oneness
as brothers and sisters with one divine parentage.**

(HOLY SPIRIT cont'd)

To this end –

**we are given the gifts and fullness of the Spirit
to be equipped and empowered for ministry;**

we are given the Scriptures, the Word of God written,
through which God continues to speak to the Church and the world today;

we are given the sacraments.

**Through baptism we become members of the body of Christ,
reminded that our sins are forgiven and we are new people,
resurrected in Christ.**

Through the Lord's Supper we are fed by the presence of Christ
and participate in his suffering
through the remembrance of his shed blood on the cross for us.

Statement of Faith: CONSUMMATION

I hope for the RETURN OF CHRIST –

the consummation of God's promise of salvation,

when all that we look forward to now will become a present reality:

- when death is destroyed and we are resurrected with new bodies into eternal life
with all of God's people;
- when evil is no more and the kingdom of God is perfectly established on earth.
- when justice, holiness, and mercy find harmony
as the Spirit of God issues forth
in the praise and confession of the citizens of the kingdom
that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the everlasting blessing, honor, and glory of God.
