June brings summer and we become excited for the change of pace in this season! There is lots to be excited about and thankful for! I want to





CONGRATULATIONS, TPC Academic Scholarship Recipients!

The TPC Academic Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce the award of six academic scholarships for 2022. These scholarships are not only important financially to the students and the families of students attending college or graduate school, but also represent our church family's prayerful support for them. Since initiated in 2016, TPC has awarded 17 scholarships totaling \$52,0000.


