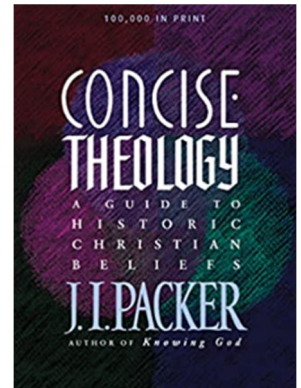
MEN'S BOOK CLUB

Deacons Quarterly Offering in August

The Board of Deacons is looking forward to the Quarterly Offering this August as your generous contributions to that fund allow Templeton Presbyterian church to meet needs near and far. Recently, we donated \$1,000 to World Renew Disaster Relief to help with Ukrainian refugees pouring into Eastern Europe to escape the war brought on by Russia. World Renew's thank you letter to TPC said, "Gifts like yours, to World Renew, help extend hope to conflict-affected families through food, shelter, medicine, and more. One refugee family receiving food cried, 'Our God is so gracious.' For this family and for those your gift touches, hope is not lost! Thank you!" Also, TPC regularly provides food and gas vouchers through Templeton Market and Deli—about \$300 per month or more.

Finally, with the guidance of Pastor Roger, the deacons will be transitioning to parishes based on 6 geographical areas here in North County in an effort to build better relationships among those in each parish. 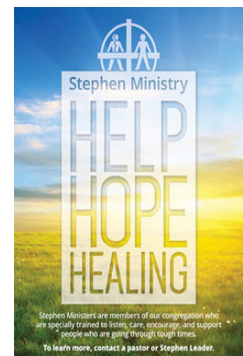
