"Don't Be That Kind of Church"

Romans 3:1-20

I. Hypothetical questions and answers (3:1-8).

- A. Q: What advantage has the Jew? A: Much, Jews were entrusted with the oracles of God.
- B. Q: Does faithlessness nullify the faithfulness of God? A: By no means! Vs. 4 is quote of Psalm 51.
- C. Q: Is God unrighteous to inflict wrath on us? A: By no means! God's wrath is how the world is judged.
- D. Q: Should I just do evil so good may come? A: This is slanderous and condemnation is just.

II. Indictment against humanity (3:9-18).

- A. All, both Jews and Greeks are under sin (Gk.Hamartia-"to miss the mark").
- B. As it is written in the scriptures:
 - 1. Psalm 14:1-3/53:1-3.
 - 2. Psalm 5:9.
 - 3. Psalm 140:3.
 - 4. Psalm 10:7.
 - 5. Proverbs 1:16, 3:15-17, Isaiah 59:7,8.
 - 6. Psalm 36:1.

III. Through the law comes knowledge of sin (3:19-20).
