Romans 1:18-32

"Be Grateful for the Wrath of God"

Intro: It may seem counterintuitive to say, but the wrath of God is a very good thing!

- I. What is the wrath of God (1:18).
- A. Two key Greek words we translate as "wrath/anger."
 - 1. thymos: Heat rising up. Think about the word "thermometer."
 - 2. orge: The natural result of a process, like a fruit ripening.
 - a. Luke 4:16-30.
 - b. Mark 3:1-6.
- B. Revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth (see 1:17).
- II. Why is the wrath of God revealed against men (1:19-23).
 - A. Because knowledge of God is plain to all people and we are without excuse.
 - 1. Acts 14:8-18.
 - 2. Acts 17:22-34.
 - B. Though we know God, we do not honor Him or give Him thanks. We exercise idolatry.
- III. So what is the result (1:24-32).

Key phrase "God gave them up" "The wrath of abandonment." See Judges 16:19-21.

- A. God gave them up to impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies.
 - 1. Truth is exchanged for a lie.
 - 2. They worship and serve a creature instead of the Creator.
- B. God Gave them up to dishonorable passions.
 - 1. Contrary to nature.
 - 2. Shameless (indecent) acts.
 - 3. Receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.
- C. God gave them up to a debased (depraved/reprobate) mind.
 - 1. They are filled with: unrighteousness, evil, covetousness, malice, envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness.
 - 2. They are: gossips, slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless.
 - 3. They know better, yet continue to do them and approve of those who practice them.

Conclusion: Just like a bad doctor wouldn't tell you what was wrong if you were sick or why you were receiving the treatment you were receiving, An unrighteous God would do the same. We have a righteous God. He tells us what is wrong. He tells us what is happening, and He tells us how it will be fixed.
