"Saved By Grace Through Faith" Romans 3:21-31

I. We are justified by grace through faith (3:21-26).

- A. The righteousness of God, displayed in the Scripture is made known through faith in Jesus Christ (vs. 21-22).
- B. We are justified by God's grace through the redemption in Christ Jesus (vs. 23-24).
- C. Jesus is the propitiation for our sins (vs. 25).
- D. Jesus' substitutionary atonement demonstrates the justice of God and the love of God (vs. 26).
- II. This justification by faith is for both Jews and Gentiles alike (3:27-31).
 - A. Boasting is excluded by the law of faith (vs. 27).
 - B. A person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law (vs. 28).
 - C. God will justify the circumcised and the uncircumcised through faith (vs. 29-30).
 - D. We do not overthrow the law; we uphold the law by this faith (vs. 31).
