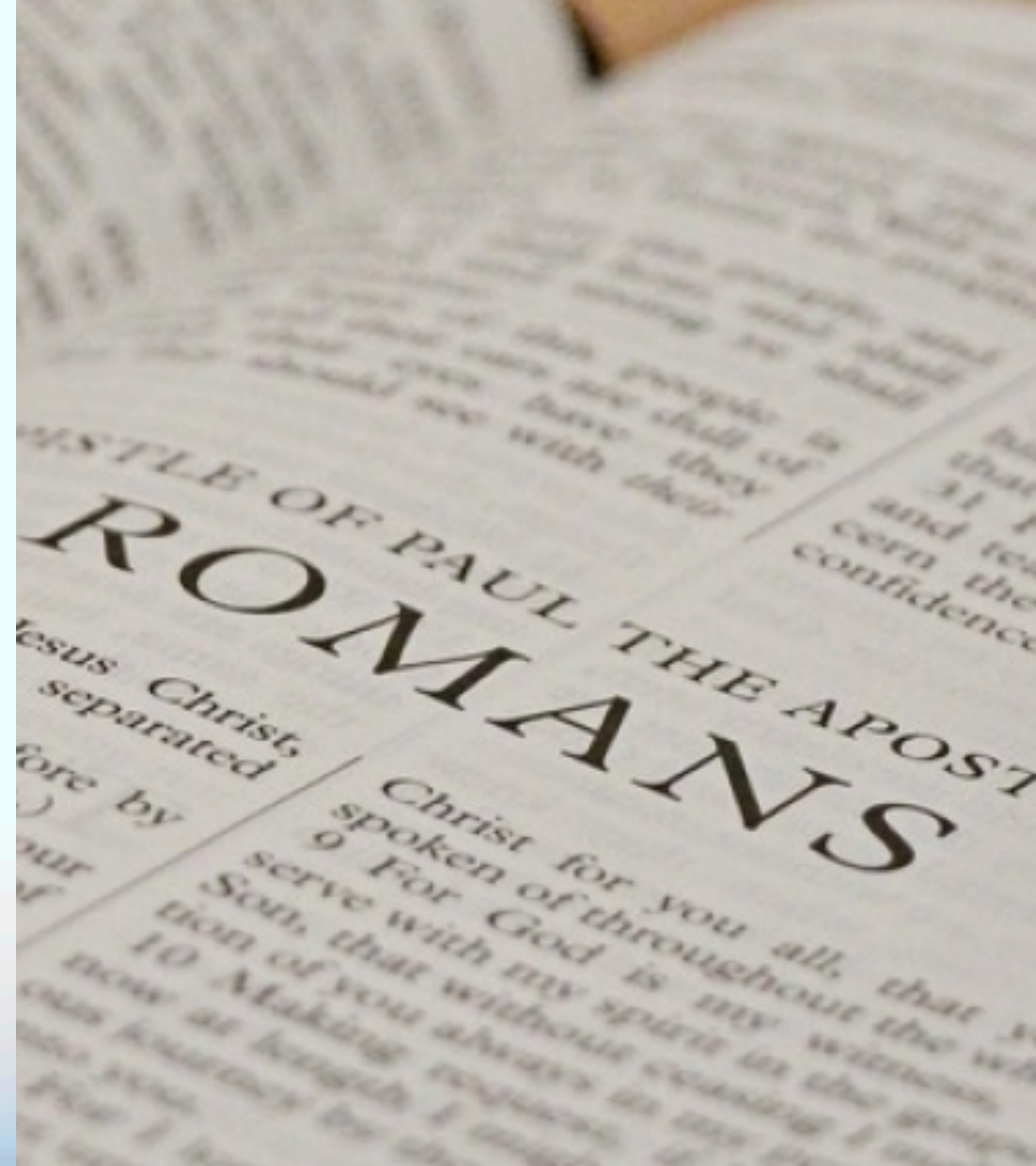

1. God's Righteousness in the Death of Jesus (3:21-26)

- Now
- Apart from the law-Not based on human merit
- As fulfillment of Scripture
- Through faith in Jesus Christ
- For all who believe

- Because Jesus' blood propitiated God's wrath
- Propitiated:Satisfied
- Substitutionary atonement

2. Righteousness by Faith for Jews and Gentiles (3:27-31)

Our faith is not in what we have done
by what Christ has done for us.

Atoning death

Christ represents the perfect fulfillment
of the law.

Affirms the abiding moral norms of the
law.

3. Abraham as the Father of Jews and Gentiles (4:1-25)

Abraham believed (had faith) first,
then he was circumcised.

He had to trust God more.

See God as even more deserving joy.
