So, enjoy these last few days of summer. I pray God's blessings on us as we head into the fall, and I look forward to being the church with you.



A number of years ago we had the opportunity to interview "Rudy" (name changed to preserve confidentiality) about the difference having a Stephen Minister made in his life. Recently, we talked with Rudy again, and he gave us permission to share what's happened since then:

A while after the caring relationship closed, I wanted to give back after the life-changing care I received, so I decided to become a Stephen Minister myself. I've now been a Stephen Minister for 17 years.

When my Stephen Minister went into hospice near the end of his life, I had the privilege of being there for him just as he had been for me. And I was there as he drew his last breath.

All those years ago when I first met my Stephen Minister, my first thought was 'How is he going to help me?' I never could have known the impact he would have on my life or the blessing our relationship would be.


