"Fulfilling Our Christian Obligations"

Romans 13:8-14

It is vital that we fulfill our Christian obligations to God and each other.
How do we do this?

- I. Love each other (vs. 8-10).
 - a. Love is a debt that is never paid in full.
 - b. Love is the fulfillment of the commandments (law).
 - i. See the Ten Commandments.
 - ii. See Jesus (Mark 12:28-34).
- II. See the present in light of the future (vs. 11-14).
 - a. The time (Kairos) has come to wake up.
 - i. Matthew 16:3.
 - ii. Mark 13:32-33.
 - b. Since the fullness of salvation is upon us (a new dawn), we must:
 - i. Cast off works of darkness and put on the armor of light.
 - ii. Walk decently.
 1. Not in orgies and drunkenness
 2. Not in sexual immorality and sensuality.
 3. Not in quarreling and jealousy.
 - iii. Put on Christ and not let the desires of the flesh overtake us.
