

Luke 5:33-39

"You Have to Be Ready for Change"

Context

- I. Luke 5:1-11: Jesus Calls the First Disciples.
 - a. These disciples are professional fishermen.
 - b. Jesus calls them into a new way of life.
 - c. They leave everything and follow Him.
- II. Luke 5:12-16: Jesus Cleanses a Leper.
 - a. A leper approaches Jesus and asks for healing.
 - b. Jesus gives the leper a new lease on life but instructs him to go and obey the Law.
 - c Word about Jesus spreads and many come to receive healing (see also Mark 1:40-45).
- III. Luke 5: 17-26: Jesus Heals a Paralytic.
 - As Jesus is teaching, Pharisees and teachers of the law were sitting listening to Him.
 - b. Some men bring a paralyzed man to Jesus by letting the man down through the roof of the house. Jesus recognizes their faith and pronounces forgiveness of sins to the paralyzed man.
 - c. The scribes and Pharisees question Jesus' actions regarding forgiveness.
 - d. Jesus responds to their questions by healing the man of his infirmity.
 - e. The people are amazed and glorify God.
- IV. Luke 5:27-32: Jesus Calls Levi.
 - a. Jesus calls a tax collector named Levi to follow Him.
 - b. Levi leaves everything behind and follows Jesus.
 - c. Levi throws a feast at his home for Jesus and there is a large company of tax collectors and others present.
 - d. The Pharisees and scribes grumble about Jesus eating and drinking with tax collectors and sinners.
 - e. Jesus says He has come to call not the righteous but sinners to repentance.
