Matthew 11:16-19

"The Game is Better When We Play"

How receptive are we to the new thing Jesus is doing?

I. What is He doing (Matthew 10:5-15)?

- A. Sending out the church to proclaim, "The kingdom of heaven is at hand."
 - 1. Sick people are healed.
 - 2. That which is dead is restored to life.
 - 3. Untouchables are made part of the community.
 - 4. Evil is conquered by good.
- B. Challenging the church to go with humility and reliance upon the generosity of others.
- C. Placing the burden on those we are being sent to be receptive or not.

II. What should we expect (Matthew 10:16-42)?

- A. We are going to be vulnerable to danger.
 - 1. People will betray you, hurt you, and seek to destroy you.
 - 2. Families will turn on each other.
 - 3. You will be hated because of the One who has sent you.
- B. We should have no fear.
 - 1. The truth will come to light.
 - 2. The One sending us is the One we are accountable to.
- C. Those who receive the message will be rewarded.
