It would be my privilege to serve this church and our community in this role.



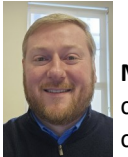

I look forward to making strong intergenerational connections within our church community. I believe becoming an Elder is the next step God is calling me to take.

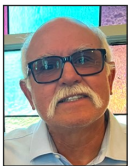
I am grateful for this opportunity to be of service at TPC.
