He bled and died / To take away my sin

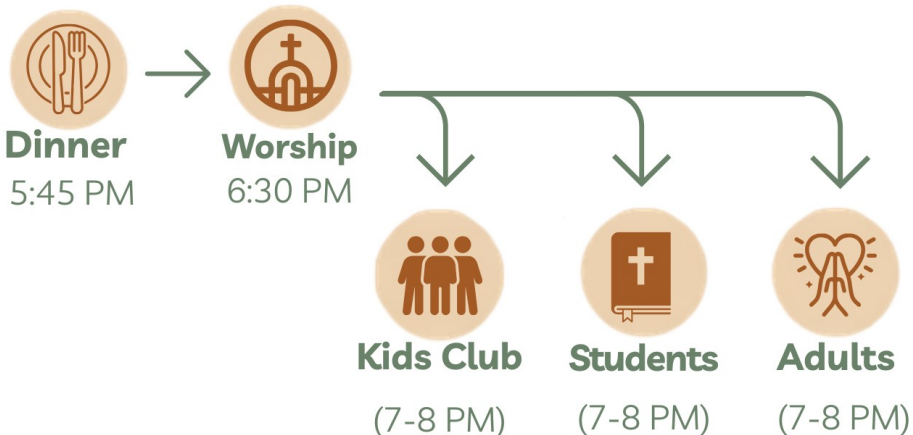
When Christ shall come / With shout of acclamation
